



"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me." (Galatians 2:20)

Galatians 2:20 is a brilliant verse that we should meditate upon often. There is much to be said about Jesus' incarnation, ministry, death, and resurrection and what it means

Our life as a Christian is to embody the life of Jesus in every single way, including his death. Jesus' death on the cross is at the center of the gospel. He died for us so that our sins might be forgiven, but His death is also an example for us to imitate. We are to die to ourselves.

The goal of the Christian life is to be formed into the image of Christ. The message of the cross says we do not live for ourselves, but we live for Jesus. This means we may have to forfeit some of our rights and deny ourselves the fulfillment of certain desires. We do this so that we might experience the joy of being united with Christ and living for a purpose much greater than ourselves.
