



“Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves is to do so as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.” (1 Peter 4:11)

Words and actions are what comprises a life. At any moment, we are saying or doing something. In a single

verse, Peter addresses how we are to live. As we strive to be like Jesus, we must pay attention to what we say and do.

Perhaps the most challenging of these two commands is the first. Our words often get us into trouble (James 3:2-12). Before we speak we should consider what would God say. We are to use our words to speak truth, build up, encourage, correct when necessary, and proclaim good news.

Peter goes on to remind us that when we serve, we do so because God has given us the strength to serve. We need this reminder because we like pats on the back. What should shine through our actions is not how great we are, but how great God is. We serve to glorify God. We speak to glorify God. We live to glorify God. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.
