Truthful Lips

"There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing. Truthful lips will endure forever, but a lying tongue is only for a moment." (Proverbs 12:18,19)

Caring about words can be difficult in our time because truth is being assaulted on all sides. If truth no longer matters, then words no longer matter. Without truth, there is little opportunity for the gospel because if others cannot trust our words, then how can

we speak to them about Jesus?

How are we to live in a world full of lies?

Do not participate in lies. If you know something is a lie, then don't involve yourself in that lie. Don't make excuses for it. Don't give in. Don't think it is ok because others are embracing it.

Ask yourself, "Do I *know* this is true, or do I *wish* it to be true?" Knowing something is true and wishing something is true are not the same.

Silence is always an option, as well. James tells us to be slow to speak. If you don't know or are unsure, then you don't have to say anything. People are perceived to be wise, not because they know everything, but because they know when not to speak.

It is not easy living in the midst of an abundance of lies but remember "truthful lips will endure forever."
