Apathy

Looking out over her class, the English teacher asked if anyone could define the word “apathy.” No one answered, so she called on a half-asleep student in the back. “Billy! Do you know what the word apathy means?” The boy roused and said, “I don’t know. And I don’t care.” “Exactly right!” said the teacher.

The New Testament doesn’t mention “apathy” by name, but there is a Greek word for it—“apatheia.” Yes, our English word “apathy” comes almost directly from the Greek; it means “lack of passion.”

I’ve often wondered why the most exciting, important mission in life can leave some apathetic. You’d think that such a high, heavenly calling would flush out all our apathy and make us the most excited people on earth! But for some, it doesn’t.

So, what’s the problem? Well, we all get apathetic at times because we’re ignoring a basic fundamental of life-things that aren’t nourished run out of energy. Your vehicle periodically needs fuel. Your body needs regular rest and nourishment. And our spiritual life needs replenishing too. We can do this by (1) prayer (2) reading God’s word, (3) time around other believers, and (4) time for physical rest & recreation.

So, to avoid apathy we have to “fuel-up” the spirit regularly. Begin with prayer - ask the Father to let His Spirit help you back to a life of passionate enthusiasm.
