Sacrifices

The old law made it very clear that only priests were to offer sacrifices before the Lord. In other words, you couldn't set up an altar in their back yard and make sacrifices for yourself. It had to be in the place God designated once they entered the land and the priests would offer the sacrifices for them on the altar.

However, though the priest offered the sacrifice for you, he would not kill it for you. That was your job. You did that for yourself. After placing your hand on the head of the burnt offering, you would then take a knife and slit the throat so all of the blood would be drained out.

God was teaching them (and us) that the priest was not responsible for the death of that innocent animal, nor was God responsible. You killed the animal. It was your fault that it died. Your sins resulted in its death.

In the same way, our sins led to the death of Jesus. He did not die for His sins, but for ours. Never forget that it is through the sacrificial blood of Jesus, the Lamb of God, that we have forgiveness of sins. "He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed." (I Pet 2:24)
