**Be Holy**

Throughout the Old Testament God declares Himself to be holy. He declares His people to be holy and constantly reminds them of this calling. The definition of holy is “dedicated or consecrated to God; set apart.” Why do you think God is having to tell His people constantly about holiness and remind them to be holy?

It is quite easy to get distracted, isn't it? In our world today we have tons of distractions that drag us away from aiming and striving to be holy in the sight of God. God gave the Israelites rules, gave them leaders to remind them, and declared to them that they are His holy people. Leviticus 20:26 says: “You are to be holy to me because I, the Lord, am holy, and I have set you apart from the nations to be my own.” The New Testament echoes this idea: “but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior; because it is written, ‘You shall be holy, for I am holy.’” (I Pet 1:15,16). It is God’s aim that His people be holy—both then and now!

Are you set apart for His service? Are you following His commands? I pray that when someone sees you, wherever you are, they see the holiness of God. That is His intention—for you to be set apart. I hope that is your aim and intention as well.
