Contentment

“Not that I speak from want, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstances I am. I know how to get along with humble means, and I also know how to live in prosperity; in any and every circumstance I have learned the secret of being filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need. I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.” (Php 4:11-13)

Discontentment is rarely the result of not having something we need, but rather the desire of wanting something we don't have to get. The problem is not about our inability to acquire, but about our desire for more. We must understand that Christ is the answer to many of the desires within us. We don't need more possessions, more pleasure, or more money. Having more will not ultimately fulfill our desires. We need the mind of Christ that causes us to abandon our selfishness and to think of others.

Contentment is about more than what we possess. It is also about our relationships, our circumstances, and our environment. When we constantly feel angry or upset, then we are discontent. If we can't find goodness in others or our circumstances, then we are likely discontent. The problem is not outside but inside. It is not that others or our circumstances are the causes of our discontentment. The problem is we need a deeper relationship with Christ. Contentment is found in knowing Christ. Aaron
