Disciples

Although the word “Christian” is only found three times in the New Testament, the word “disciple” is found over 250 times. Scripture has much to say about being a disciple and yet it is not often mentioned in current church settings. We know what a Christian is, but what is a disciple?

The definition of the Greek word translated disciple is "to become a pupil." Disciples were people who sat at Jesus' feet and learned from his teaching, but they were also people who followed Him and imitated His actions. To be a disciple of Jesus is to desire to be like Jesus in every way.

Jesus says His disciples will “continue in His word” (Jn 8:31), “love one another” (Jn 13:35), and “bear fruit” (Jn 15:8). How would you grade yourself in these areas? Are you doing the things that Jesus said a disciple of His would do?

Discipleship is about transformation and learning to live like Jesus. It means we must continually study the teachings of Jesus so that they become a part of who we are. Becoming a disciple is going to require more than an hour or two a week. We cannot expect to become a disciple of Jesus simply by attending Sunday worship. We must spend time in God's word, in prayer, and in the practice of living like Jesus every day. Live like a disciple of Jesus this week.
