Mercy & Grace

“Yet I was shown mercy because I acted ignorantly in unbelief; and the grace of our Lord was more than abundant, with the faith and love which are found in Christ Jesus.” (I Timothy 1:13,14). As believers we must never lose sight of the fact that we do not deserve God’s mercy and grace. The apostle Paul plainly admitted he was no better than anyone else. In fact, he called himself “the foremost” of sinners (I Tim 1:15).
