## Common Ground

**“For though I am free from all men, I have made myself a slave to all, so that I may win more...I have become all things to all men, so that I may by all means save some. I do all things for the sake of the gospel, so that I may become a fellow partaker of it.” (I Cor 9:19, 22b, 23)**

**In a polarized world, we often highlight and focus on our differences. News networks and talk radio obsess over what divides us. The apostle Paul lived in a world that in many ways was more divided than our own. Various groups hated one another, sometimes for good reason. Violence was not uncommon. At one point in Jesus’ ministry, His disciples wished to “command fire to come down from heaven” to destroy Samaritans (Lk 9:54).**

**In the midst of this hostility, Paul said “I have become all things to all men.” In a polarized world, Paul was looking for commonalities rather than differences. Why? He was doing it to win people to Christ. He says, “I do all things for the sake of the gospel.” What we can do for the kingdom of God is more important than any differences we may have. Paul was willing to put aside differences and become like something he was not in order to share the good news. What are you willing to do in order to share the good news?**
