## Power & Love

“My soul waits in silence for God only; from Him is my salvation. He only is my rock and my salvation, my stronghold; I shall not be greatly shaken.” (Psa 62:1,2)

If I stop reading the psalm there, I will miss that this is a statement of realistic faith, not wishful thinking. David knows human nature and that “shaken” does not mean he will be left unchallenged. He is unshaken because his salvation comes from God—not from men.

If I stop at verse two, I miss the spiritually critical reminder that all people are but a breath in comparison to God. What matters is summed up by David at the end of the psalm in verses 11, 12: “Once God has spoken; twice I have heard this: That power belongs to God; and lovingkindness is Yours, O Lord, for you reward a man according to his work.”

Power belongs to God, not to me, you, or anyone else. His unflinching love is what I must be seeking for He will judge us by our actions on the day His Son and our Savior comes again.

On my own I would be nothing, but in Christ I am the recipient of God’s love, mercy, grace, and forgiveness. He is my hope, my rock, my salvation, my fortress, and refuge—and He is all this for you too, if you will seek your rest in God alone.
