## What Is Church?

What is church? This may seem like an unusual thing to ask, but it's important. The English word church has multiple different meanings. It can refer to a building or a denomination. The word church in the pages of Scripture, however, does not refer to either one of these. The Greek word translated church means "called out." Church is a community of people called to serve Jesus.

In Acts 2:42-47, we are given a description of church. This description is not exhaustive. A church can be more than what is described in this passage, but it should not be anything less.

Culturally, we have reduced church to something we do one hour on Sunday. We go to church. Nowadays, however, a person may "go to church" only every other week or once a month.

At its very essence, church is community. It is eating together, serving together, praying together, learning together, spending time together, and worshipping together. We cannot choose one of these, neglect the others, and say it is church. Church is a called-out community. It is people committed to Jesus who are doing life together. It is people who share one another's burdens. It is people who care for one another. It is people who are committed to one another. The cultural idea of church will fade because it is incomplete. The Acts 2 model of church will continue to flourish because it transforms lives and communities.
